**ANIMAL PROTECTION AND CONTROL (DOG LICENCE
AND IDENTIFICATION TAG FEES) REGULATIONS, 2023**

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred by section 36(1) of the Animal Protection and Control Act, 2010 (*No. 19 of 2010*) hereby makes the following regulations —

1. Citation and commencement.

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Animal Protection and Control (Dog Licence and Identification Tag Fees) Regulations, 2023.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st July, 2023.

2. Interpretation.

In these Regulations —

“**intact**” means a dog that has not been spayed or neutered;

“**neutered**” means a dog whose testes have been removed by way of surgical procedure;

“**spayed**” means a dog whose female reproductive organs have been removed by way of surgical procedure.

3. Certificate evidence spayed or neutered.

Any person applying for a licence and identification tag for a spayed or neutered dog shall produce a certificate from a licensed veterinarian showing that the dog has been spayed or neutered.

4. Fees.

- (1) The fees specified in the second column of the *Schedule* shall be in respect of that licence specified in the first column of the *Schedule*.
- (2) Any fee or charge collected under these Regulations shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund.
