offers ambulatory care, laboratory and x-ray services, specialized care, and maternal and child health care; have the capacity and/or infrastructure to perform diagnostics.

Main Clinic: Health Facility with resident/visiting Medical Officer, consists of resident nurse and no overnight bed facility; offers maternal and child health services and minimal emergency care.

Satellite Clinic: Small facility for visiting medical and nursing staff (weekly, bi-monthly, or monthly visits); clinics are usually in a remote area.
