INCREASING THE VALUE ADDED TO NUTMEG IN GRENADA

GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

The Government of Grenada (GOGR) has obtained a grant from the Caribbean Aid for Trade and Regional Integration Trust Fund (CARTFund) which is administered by the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) and financed by the UK Department for International Development (DFID) in an amount equivalent to USD361,459 towards the cost of the project "*Increasing the Value Added to Nutmeg in Grenada*" and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this grant to eligible payments under contracts procured under this Project.

Payments by CDB will be made only at the request of GOGR, and upon approval by CDB, and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement. The Grant Agreement prohibits withdrawal from the financing account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than GOGR shall derive any rights from the Grant Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Grant.

The following consultancy services assignments will be procured under the Project:

- (a) Project and Nutmeg Cluster Coordinator;
- (b) Product Development Consultant; and
- (c) Business Development Consultants.

It is expected that these services will be procured during the period April to September 2013.
